REI CASE 3 Part C

The patient's husband completed a course of doxycycline and had a repeat semen analysis, which still showed 1.6 million WBCs/mL.

The patient was lost to follow up and during that time was diagnosed with an ectopic pregnancy. She was told this was cornual pregnancy and underwent a right salpingo-oophorectomy 6 months ago at an outside institution.

She then underwent 2 cycles of Clomid with intrauterine insemination and did not become pregnant. Her 3rd cycle was held secondary to the development of a large dominant follicle. Also noted on U/S was a 3.5cm intramural fibroid deviating the endometrial cavity to the left. The patient complains of increasingly heavy menses and significant dysmenorrhea.
