Ms. Ritchie returns for post-operative appointment. Because the septum resection was challenging, an HSG is done. The HSG is normal at this point with fill and spill of both tubes.

Subsequently, the patient becomes pregnant with timed intercourse and then presents with another miscarriage at 7 weeks.
